

## **Brentwood Campus Volunteer Needs**

**Tutoring** – If you are interested in volunteering your time by tutoring, our Tutor House hours are Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Most of our children are in middle and high school and need help in the subjects of Math, Science, Social Studies, and English.

**Houseparent's Night Out** – This is an opportunity for a small group to interact with all of our children. Houseparent's Night Out gives the houseparents much needed time away. Houseparent's Night Out generally takes place on Friday nights from 6:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. This event is for the whole campus. You can provide food, snacks, or no food at all. For activities you can play games, watch a movie, or have open gym. Be creative and have fun with it. We have found this event works best when hosted by a small group of young adults or adults from churches or corporations. There are a limited amount of dates for this opportunity.

**Cottage Night Out** – This is an opportunity for a small group to interact with children and houseparents from one cottage. You can take the cottage out to eat, go to a movie, play laser tag, and more.

**Prayerwalking** – This gives individuals or groups the opportunity to tour our campus while praying for the needs of our ministry and its children. The guided tour takes about 45 minutes to one hour to complete. Prayer guides are provided.

**Service projects** – From time to time there are work projects available for youth groups/individuals for small projects and for skilled groups/individuals for painting and larger projects.

**Receptionist** – This opportunity allows you to help the office side of the ministry. You will help the staff answer the phone and greet visitors during the lunch hour.
